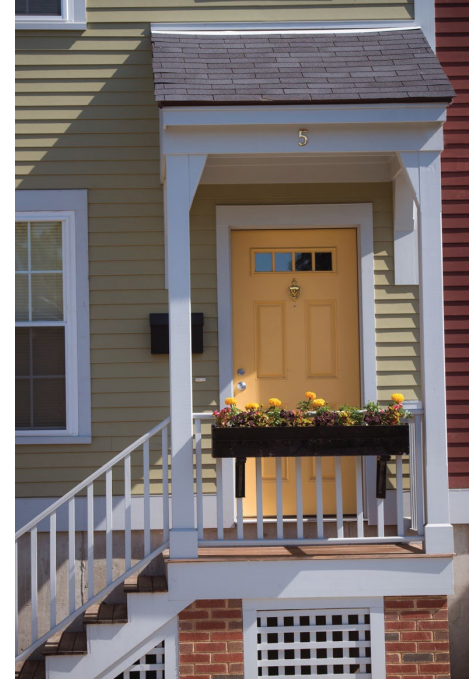
HHP: Program Overview

- Intended to create partnerships between housing developments and healthcare providers to increase positive health outcomes and housing stability
- Pilot (second round) – Hope to learn if having healthcare services easily accessible within the housing development will increase these outcomes
- Models: Co-location of healthcare services or care coordination of healthcare services



Program Overview – Examples

- Co-location of healthcare services
 - Mental health services
 - Children/youth focused care
 - Services for the elderly
 - Substance use services
- Care Coordination of healthcare services
 - Management of chronic disease medical needs
 - Elderly patients facing complex needs
 - Primary healthcare connections and coordination



These are **examples** – RIHousing defers to applicants to determine the healthcare needs of residents and demonstrate that need

Shannock Falls, Richmond

Description

- Care Coordination Model
- Community Health Worker onsite – managing health concerns and challenges, connecting to local resources, navigating health insurance, education related to healthcare needs, addressing social determinants of health
- Transportation services to improve access to services and complete errands (WRH facilities, pharmacy, grocery, etc)



Eligibility/Threshold Requirements



- Must be a RIHousing financed development (Attachment D in RFP)
- Housing development cannot be scattered site
- Housing development must be located within one of 15 Health Equity Zones
- Must have an MOU between healthcare provider and housing development
- Healthcare worker must provide services **onsite** at the housing development
