This Notice shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for an activity to be undertaken by Rhode Island Housing and Mortgage Finance Corporation (“RIHousing”).

**REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS**

On or about April 3, 2023, RIHousing will submit a request to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the release of HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds under Title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 for the following project:

Valley Affordable Housing Corporation  
Reynolds Farm Senior Housing II Apartments  
10 Driftwood Lane  
North Kingstown, RI 02852

Valley Affordable Housing Corporation, proposes the acquisition of land and new construction of the Reynolds Farm Senior Housing II Apartments (RFSH-II), with an age fifty-five (55) plus years resident restriction, for low-income affordable rental housing. The development consists of forty (40) apartments, in a single three-story building that includes thirty-one (31) one-bedroom and nine (9) two-bedroom apartments, for low-income households earning less than 60% AMI and six (6) of the units will be reserved for households earning less than 30 percent AMI.

Proposed: Eleven (11) residential rental units will be HOME Program assisted  
Proposed HOME Award: \$1,000,000  
Total Development Project Cost: \$14,727,172

**FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT**

Rhode Island Housing has determined that this project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, Environmental Impact Statements under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) are not required. #### PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency disagreeing with this determination or wishing to comment on the project may submit written comments on the ERR to RIHousing.

All comments received by March 31, 2023, will be considered by RIHousing prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify the Notice they are addressing.

#### RELEASE OF FUNDS

RIHousing certifies to HUD that Carol A. Ventura, in her capacity as Executive Director consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows RIHousing to use Program funds.

#### OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and RIHousing's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of RIHousing (b) RIHousing has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted via email in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD at Department of Housing and Urban Development, Office of Community Planning and Development, at: [CPD\\_COVID-19OEE-BOS@hud.gov](mailto:CPD_COVID-19OEE-BOS@hud.gov). Potential objectors should contact HUD at Department of Housing and Urban Development, Office of Community Planning and Development, via email to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
