In March 2019, RIHousing issued a new LIHTC compliance manual which had been developed specifically for owners and managers of LIHTC rental developments in Rhode Island. With ongoing changes to federal guidance and industry best practices, it is important that the manual be regularly updated so that is remains relevant and helpful. We are pleased to announce that once again we partnered with Costello Compliance and completed a revision to the LIHTC Compliance Manual. The revised edition is attached to this program bulletin, the previous version is now obsolete.

The revised Manual (the "Manual") can also be found in .pdf format on our website: <u>www.rihousing.com</u> The significant revisions, though few in quantity, include clarification of RIHousing policies, and deeper discussions on both the AIT (Average Income Test), RMDs, and acquisition/rehabilitation projects. Minor revisions such as correction of typos, adjustments to clip art, and formatting of the Multiple Programs Chart are not highlighted.
