Questions and Answers

3/8/2023

Q: If we were recently awarded the **RI Housing Comprehensive Community Development Program and Project Funding** and the scope includes 9 RIH funded properties. Can we also apply for this **RIH Resident Services Funding** grant for one specific property, if the property is also in the scope of the RIH CCDP grant? Due to the challenges with the population this development houses, we are hoping to apply to have the new service coordination model at this one property that houses the homeless.

A: Yes, you may apply if you are proposing to expand the scope of your current service coordination model.

3/7/2023

Q: Our loan is with RIHMFC. Would this grant allow us to hire an RSC for our community?

A: Yes.

2/14/2022

Q: I am working with Crossroads on the financing and development of the Summer Street project in Providence, a 176 unit development for homeless individuals. The proposal states that RIHousing seeks proposals to support people living in RIHousing financed developments. As the Summer Street project is not yet fully financed by RIH (we hope it to be soon), is the project **not** eligible for consideration?

A: Correct, the project is not eligible for consideration. The purpose of this RFP is to support residents through resident service coordination, which would require the project to be occupied at the start of the grant term (anticipated summer 2023).

Q: Is Lucy's Hearth considered a RI Housing financed development?

A: Yes.
