RI Legal Services (RILS) will accept referrals and provide legal support eviction prevention and defense services for residents of both private and public housing who RILS deems to be eligible for such services. For private tenants, RILS may assist those who fall below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines. RILS will endeavor to represent clients for whom the Center for Justice (CFJ) has a conflict of interest. Undocumented applicants will be referred to CFJ for eviction prevention and defense services.

The Center for Justice (CJF) will accept referrals and provide eviction prevention and defense services for private housing applicants, particularly those who are otherwise ineligible for representation from RI Legal Services (RILS), including those who are undocumented, or where a conflict may apply. CFJ will endeavor to represent both private market and public housing clients for whom RILS has a conflict of interest. CFJ will also represent tenants who are above 200% of federal poverty guidelines up to the 80% of Area Median Income eligibility guideline for the RentReliefRI program.
